Call for Papers in Hebrew & Jewish Studies

Extended Deadline for Abstract Submission: Tuesday, November 15th, 2022, 11:59 PM EST

We are excited to bring together scholars of Hebrew & Jewish Studies to Lexington. We welcome abstracts in all areas of this field, including but not limited to:

- Modern Hebrew/ Israeli literature
- Modern Hebrew language pedagogy
- Yiddish Language & Literature
- Sephardi/Mizrahi Studies and Cultures
- Biblical Hebrew & Literature
- Hebrew and Semitic linguistics
- Old Testament Studies
- Jewish History
- World Jewish Languages

Paper presentations are 20 minutes, followed by a 10-minute question & answer session. In addition to **individual abstracts** for paper presentations, **proposals for panels** are also welcome. For more information, please contact Martin Luther Chan (<u>martinluther@uky.edu</u>).

Individually submitted abstracts should be no more than 250 words.

Panel proposals (between 3-5 presentations) should be submitted as follows: <u>The panel organizer</u> <u>should electronically submit a panel proposal</u> – generally around 1 page in length and should include the theme of the panel, the organizer's name and contact information, and the names, contact information and affiliations of the panel participants. In addition to the panel proposal, <u>each participant should</u> <u>submit an individual abstract using our online system.</u> Please indicate that your presentation is part of a pre-organized panel and list the title and organizer of the panel in the abstract.

The KFLC has a tradition of attracting scholars from a broad range of languages and specializations. In addition to Hebrew & Jewish Studies, this year's conference will have sessions in Arabic and Islamic Studies, Classical Studies, East Asian Studies, French and Francophone Studies, German-Austrian-Swiss Studies, Hispanic Linguistics, Hispanic Studies (Spanish Peninsular and Spanish American), Indigenous and Endangered Languages, Intercultural Studies, Italian Studies, Language Studies for the Professions, Linguistics, Lusophone Studies, Music Studies in Language and/or Cultures, Neo-Latin Studies, Russian and Slavic Studies, Second Language Acquisition, and Translation Studies.

Be sure that your paper or panel is prepared according to the track's guidelines including, but not limited to, the format and the language of presentation. Acceptance of a paper or complete panel implies a commitment on the part of all participants to register and attend the conference. **All presenters must pay the appropriate registration fee by Wednesday, March 1**st, **2023 to be included in the program**. *Failure to pay by this deadline will result in the immediate removal of your abstract from the conference program. We will attempt to contact you before removing your presentation.*
